

WHERE: Start Georgetown Lake
WHEN: Saturday August 11th 8 am SHARP

REGISTRATION: On-line starts January 1, 2012 -August 7th.
In person starts May 1st - August 6th, 2012 at Runner's Roost (Denver, Lafayette, Aurora, Lone Tree and Lakewood), Boulder Running Company (Littleton, Greenwood Village & Boulder).
Pre Race Day on August 10th at the Buffalo Restaurant (Idaho Springs).

Race Day registration is in Idaho Springs at the entry to Administration building, only. **You must register before the last bus leaves at 6:30.**

PACKET PICK UP: All on-line registration bibs and timing chips may be picked up at Runners Roost Denver August 4th or 5th (10 am to 4 pm): the Buffalo Bar in Idaho Springs on Friday August 10th from 11 am, till 8 pm. On race day you may pick up your packet at the start in Georgetown from 6:00 to 7:00 am.

TIMING: The race will be timed with an electronic timing chip. You must wear the chip for the race duration to receive your results. There is a \$10 replacement chip charge .

AWARDS: Gold Pan Trophies will be presented at an awards ceremony at Clear Creek Football Field at approximately 11 am 1st, 2nd and 3rd place will be awarded to men and women in five-year age categories starting at age 20 and 19 and under. Unclaimed trophies must be claimed in an email to the Race Director before September 1st, 2012.

REFUND POLICY: There are **NO REFUNDS**, rollovers or transfers of bibs or entry fees. If you are unable to run you will not receive a refund, nor can you sell or give your bib to another party. Registration goes to a charitable cause.

PARKING in Idaho Springs: Allowed on streets adjacent to Clear Creek Football Field, the downtown area, and at Clear Creek Administration Building. Look for attendants when you get to Exit #240, the Mt. Evans exit. **Do not block driveways or alleys.** (see map). Cars will be towed in areas that block emergency vehicles. This is an old mining town so the streets are narrow, please be a good participant and don't block a drive or street.

PARKING in Georgetown: Around Georgetown Lake near the start. Attendants will direct you (see map). If you arrive after 6:45 am, anticipate parking at least ½ mile from the starting line. At 7 am, one hour before the race start, no one will be allowed to turn left down the service road to the starting line.

Charitable Donation: Your registration fee may be tax deductible. Check with your tax advisor. The race is Organized by the Clear Creek Booster Club a charitable 501(c)3 organization.

34th Anniversary Saturday - August 11, 2012

The Georgetown to Idaho Springs Half Marathon is one of the most pleasurable runs in the western United States. The race course parallels Clear Creek and is a very scenic, gently rolling mountain course that winds down the Clear Creek Valley. Vehicular traffic on the course is normally minimal. Be aware, however, that the road is closed only for one lane. Runners must stay to the right side of the road. Although the course is at high elevation (8500' to 7500' start to finish) it is a relatively fast one due to the gentle downhill nature. The course is certified by the USATF (CO-02020DP). The course is not compatible with wheelchairs or strollers because it includes a trail section.

TRANSPORTATION: We encourage you to carpool to the starting area in Georgetown because parking is limited, BUT PLEASE park by 6:45 am (no exceptions). If you are planning to ride the bus from Idaho Springs to Georgetown, arrive early, and expect traffic congestion. Buses will start running at 5:30 am. Board the bus at the Forest Service building next to the Clear Creek School District Administrative offices off of exit 240. Traffic Marshalls will guide you to the pick up area. Please board the first available bus. The last bus will leave at 6:30 am. If you miss the bus your alternative is to drive to Georgetown. **Transportation is not provided back to Georgetown after the race.**

GEAR BAGS: Runner's warm-up clothing will be transported from Georgetown to the Clear Creek football field in Idaho Springs. Bags will be provided, but not a bad idea to bring your own. Wear old warm-ups and we will get them to a charity.
